



The 5 Minute Stocky Migration Checklist

Get your data out before Shopify shuts Stocky down on 31 August 2026.

Stocky closes on 31 August 2026. After that the app and its APIs stop, and a short read-only window is all you get. One thing catches everyone out: your supplier records do not export. There is no bulk export, so they have to be copied by hand while the app still runs. Start down this list today.

No export exists for suppliers. That is the one thing you will lose. Do item 2 first.

- ☐ **1. Export your purchase order history**
Stocky exports POs and inventory reports. Pull them now while the app still runs.
- ☐ **2. Copy your supplier list by hand**
Name, contact, lead time, minimum order, payment terms. No export exists, so put it in a spreadsheet today.
- ☐ **3. Save your reorder points**
Note the reorder point and target stock for your key products. These do not carry across cleanly.
- ☐ **4. Export inventory and cost data**
Landed costs and stock on hand. Export everything Stocky will give you before the window closes.
- ☐ **5. Pick a replacement before August, not after**
Once Stocky is gone the export is read-only for a limited time, then nothing. Choose while the source data is live.
- ☐ **6. Import into your new tool**
Load the supplier list, reorder points, and costs so day one is running, not a rebuild.
